#### **Township Dog Ordinance:**

Please be courteous to your neighbors by keeping your dogs leashed and barking under control. It is a misdemeanor to let your dogs run at large.

#### **Shoreline Erosion:**

Please be aware of the water levels when out enjoying the lake and maintain a sufficient distance from shore to help prevent shoreline erosion caused by boat wakes. This is especially important during times when the lake levels are up!

#### Fish and Wildlife Committee Update:

John has contacted the commercial fisherman and he will be out to set up hoop nets in late April or early May in hopes of reducing the bullhead and carp population. The nets will be marked with white jugs so please do not disturb them.

The DNR will stock the lake with 100,000 walleye fry this spring in their continuing effort to manage the walleyes in the lake.

#### Other committees:

We are in need of volunteers to help with the Education Committee, the Lake Improvement Committee, the Technical Committee and the Fish and Wildlife Committee. Please consider joining a committee in order to help us maintain the high quality of lake life we desire.

#### Lake Treatments:

We received the necessary responses from association members to extend our permit from the DNR to treat the lake through 2011. Thank you!!!

<u>Curly Leaf:</u> We have 37 members signed up to treat for Curly Leaf this year. Those signed up will receive a notice and a card from Lake Management to post on their property as in years past.

Algae: We have exceeded the 50% necessary to treat for algae if needed this year. We have not had to treat the lake

for algae in the past 2 years. We believe one reason for this is the drive to get curly leaf out of the lake and let the native species start to re-establish.

#### Other items:

CapX2020 – As most of you are aware, there is a plan to extend high voltage utility lines from Monticello to Fargo and our lake could potentially be in or very near the path. The board will draft a letter on behalf of lake residents with our concerns and we encourage you to do the same.

Remember to renew or obtain your <u>swim</u> <u>raft permit</u> from the Wright County Sheriff's Dept. Contact the records dept at 763-682-7622. Your permit number must be displayed on the raft and the raft must be reflectorized on all sides.
