### Lake Treatments:

Those who signed up to treat for aquatic plants should have had their shoreline treated on June 22<sup>nd</sup>. ### Voluntary No-Wake:

The Lake Association Board Members encourage all boaters to observe a voluntary no-wake zone in the small bay where the creek comes into the lake in order to minimize the stirring up of sediment from the lake bottom. Please remind your friends and neighbors!

### Keep your distance!!!:

Remember to maintain safe distances (150 feet) from docks, swim platforms, shore and others on the lake when tubing and boating. This includes jumping wakes with personal watercraft!
