Complete the online boating safety course [Boat Minnesota](#) to receive a youth Minnesota watercraft operator's permit (12 to 17 years old).

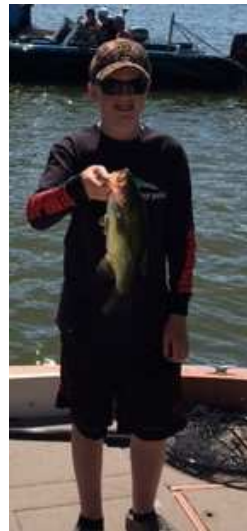
